# Common Estate Planning Documents

Will/Trust - Property transfer at death

<u>Durable Powers of Attorney</u> - Allows for another person (Agent) to make medical and financial decisions for you when you are unable

Health Care Directive (Living Will) - End-of-life document that allows you to indicate to doctors whether you want artificial nutrition or hydration

<u>Community Property Agreement</u> - allows married couples to avoid probate after first spouse passes

<u>POLST (Physician Order of Life-Sustaining Treatment)</u> - bright green form that your doctor signs; applies to paramedics

#### <u>Legal</u> **Documents That Establish** Ownership, Relationships, **Property Rights**

Guardianship/Conservatorship documents - formal appointment by the court to make legal decisions for a disabled person

<u>Divorce Decrees</u> - comes in handy to show evidence of property or retirement benefit ownership

<u>Death Certificates</u> - especially of spouse

<u>Birth Certificates, Social Security Cards</u> - yourself, spouse, minor children
