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On July 4, 2025, the president signed into law federal H.R. 1. It impacts programs managed by the Department of Social and Health Services as well as other state social services agencies. H.R. 1 includes changes to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and Medicaid (called Apple Health in our state), which serve many of our state's most vulnerable people.
